Throughout these weeks, we've had many conversations with parents reeling from the propaganda and filth forwarded from government teachers and intended to educate the children, polluting their hearts and minds. Other parents are telling us that, while they have contemplated homeschooling, they are glad to have a time to give it a try. Still others never thought they would educate their own children, but now they don't want to relinquish their children again. One dad is teaching his children music on the various musical instruments he plays and other subjects he himself loves, which he has wanted to teach his children but never had the time with them to make it happen.
