
In 1996, he co-founded Frontline Ministries, Inc., with Rev. Lee Adams, a cultural renewal ministry, and he continues to serve as its Executive Director.

He created the Exodus Mandate Project as a subsidiary of Frontline Ministries, Inc., in 1998 to assist pastors and parents to leave government education for Christian homeschooling and campus Christian schools.

He helped create the Christian Education Initiative (CEI) in 2018 with eighteen member organizations, seeking to advance Biblical Christian education and to enlighten Christians about the failures of public education encouraging them to pursue Biblical worldview education.

He served as CEI Chairman for over four years, (Oct. 2018-June 2023).

He has served as Chairman of the Board of Public School Exit since its inception in 2019, a national program assisting Christians to leave government schools, founded by Dran Reese.
